Specialty Sessions

Recommended for those 15 and older. All participants will receive individual instruction from the SLU coaching staff on a specific position.

- 3 night sessions from 4:00 pm to 7:00 pm will be set-aside for specialty sessions.
- Advanced, detailed instruction in the fundamentals and tactics of each skill will be taught in an intense 3 hour session.
- Specific position topics will include setting, outside and right-side hitting, middle hitting, and defense.

Registration

Eligibility

Any camper age 9-18 is eligible to participate.

Medical Waivers

Location

Camps will be at the Frost campus of Saint Louis University in the air-conditioned Simon Recreational Center.

Parking

Parking for Saint Louis Camp is available in the Frost garage located on Laclede Avenue, directly south of the Simon Recreation Center. Parking charges are \$1.00 an hour; charges *will not* be validated.

Drop-offs/ Pick-ups

Drop-off and pick-ups for Saint Louis camp can be made in the circle drive behind Greisedick Hall (tall building) off of Laclede Avenue. Camp supervisors will be on hand 40 minutes before camp begins and until every camper has been picked up.

What you need to bring.

Please dress in comfortable t-shirt and shorts, socks and athletic shoes. Knee-pads are recommended. Water will be available, but campers are welcome to bring a personal water bottle.

Lunch

Campers are welcome to bring their own lunch. Subway meals will be available for \$6, and orders will be taken at the beginning of camp each day. No camper will walk to Subway unsupervised.

Camp Confirmation

Camp confirmation will be emailed after the registration material is received. Please make sure the information on the confirmation is correct.

Supervision

The coaching staff supervises participants during instructional sessions and lunch break. No camper will ever be allowed to walk unsupervised through campus for any reason.

Trainers

Athletic trainers will be on duty throughout each volleyball camp. The trainers will deliver medical attention to anyone who becomes injured or ill and will dispense all primary athletic training needs. Saint Louis University Hospital facilities are at our camp's disposal should the need arise.
